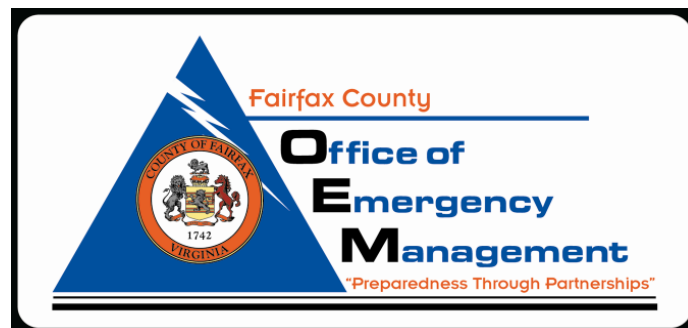

Standard Emergency Messages

Below are **agency approved standard emergency messages** to be used during severe weather events or other hazardous conditions causing a county government closing or delay.

These messages will be used by the county's Office of Emergency Management (OEM) for the CEAN county government closings and delays notification group, as well as to inform key members of the Fairfax County government and senior leadership of the county government's operating status.

These messages also will be used by the county's Office of Public Affairs (OPA) for posting to the emergency information hotline, the county Web site, media notifications, 1670 AM, will be edited into shortened crawl messages for use on Channel 16, and any other communication methods OPA may utilize to inform employees and residents of the county's operating status.

Standard emergency messages will be approved by agency contacts yearly to ensure accurate information. Additional information about weather-related emergency closings can be found on the Fairfax County Infoweb at: http://infoweb.fairfaxcounty.gov/opa/guide_for_agencies.htm.

* Most of the standard emergency messages include the following statement about the **Courts**:

The Fairfax County Circuit Court, General District Court and Juvenile and Domestic Relations District Court have not yet made a decision on operating status.

This statement will be used for the first posting of messages by OPA staff. Since the courts generally determine their status after the county and schools have issued their messages, OEM will provide OPA updated courts information for posting/updating of messages.

What are RECenters and Community Centers?

- **RECenters**: Operated by the Fairfax County Park Authority, RECenters offer exercise equipment, aquatics facilities and fitness classes at nine locations in the county.
- **Community Centers**: Operated by the Fairfax County Department of Community and Recreation Services, the nine Community Centers offer programs and activities for adults, children, teens and seniors; sports programs, and make rooms available for various community meetings, classes, socials, etc. Some centers also have fitness centers.
- **McLean Community Center** and **Reston Community Center**, which are operated separately and independently from the Park Authority, Department of Community and Recreation Services and each other, are also included in these standard emergency messages.
