Water Forms: Paintings by Pam Coulter

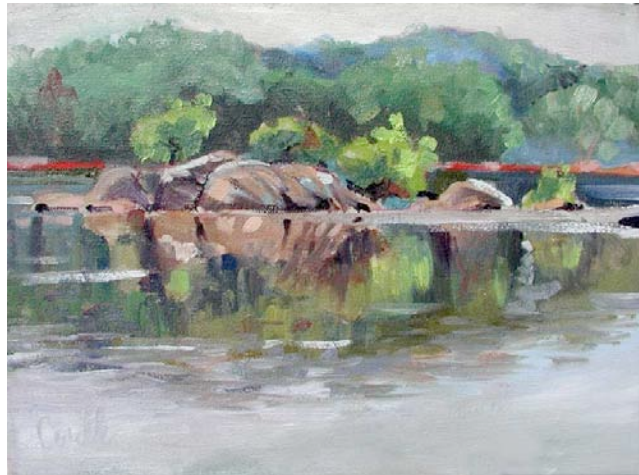


Figure 1: Cloudy Day, Riverbend

RESTON, VA – Pam Coulter’s “Water Forms” art exhibit at the Jo Ann Rose Gallery, Reston Community Center Lake Anne will take place from July 3rd through August 6th, 2007, and is open to the public on Monday through Saturday from 9:00 am to 10:00 pm, and Sunday from 1:00 pm to 9:00 pm. The public is invited to attend artist’s reception on Sunday, July 8th from 2:00 pm– 4:00 pm.

The exhibit is a retrospective of over 60 paintings spanning 42 years by this award-winning artist. The artist reminisced, “In this show, the journey starts in Greece, where I spent a year painting after graduating from Antioch College and teaching art for a year in Florida. Water has always fascinated me because of its ability to change — to reflect, to refract, to obscure, to vanish into sky, reappearing as clouds only to rain or snow down on us.”

Pam Coulter is a 3-time winner of Best in Show at the Art League Gallery at the Torpedo Factory and has won many awards in League of Reston Artists shows. She is also published in American Artist magazine (Feb 1995) and a featured acrylic painter in



the [North Light Book of Acrylic Painting Techniques](#) book. She was represented by Venable-Neslage Galleries in Washington, D.C up until its closing in 1997. In the following year, her work was displayed in the National Art Club in New York City. She participated in regional juried shows and had a number of successful one-person shows. She is currently a member of MAX_21 group in Reston and the Riverbend Plein Aire group. Her work continues to be displayed in the Art League at the Torpedo Factory and League of Reston Artists shows. She currently teaches Oil and Acrylic Painting on Wednesday Evenings at the Reston Community Center Lake Anne.
